Attached you will find the membership packet for the 2020/2021 season. We will be using the NHSRA online membership program again this year. The only 2 forms that will need to be done online (unless you are transferring in from another state) are the Membership Application and Minors Release. You can also find the transfer form online as well. Go to nhsra.com and click on Member Login (right hand side of screen) to get started.

There are 3 different methods for getting to your NHSRA profile:

1. Renewing members that have logged in to your profile already;
2. Renewing members that have never logged in; and,
3. Totally new members

If you have never logged in but are a renewing member, you already have an account (profile) set up. Please do not try to create a new account!! I have attached instructions that should help walk you through any of these 3 ways. If you were a junior high member last year and are moving up to high school, you will still have an account set up!!! Please use the Membership Year of 2020 when signing up.

Once you are in your account (profile), you will need to:

1. Pay NHSRA dues online (\$124 plus \$8.37 transaction fee); and,
2. Print out the membership application and minor's release, execute them and then upload them back to your account.

There are several different format types that the system will take. PLEASE MAKE SURE TO SIGN EVERYWHERE INDICATED AND PLEASE MAKE SURE THE NOTARY ACKNOWLEDGES (WRITES IN) ALL NAMES ON THE NOTARY LINE!!!! Once you have uploaded the executed documents back to your profile, filled in all pertinent information in your profile, you will hit Save and then Submit to District Secretary. (Programmers name it districts instead of regions.)

You will mail all other pertinent Texas forms contained in the attached packet back to me along with the full membership dues of \$171.00.

Please use the checklist provided to make sure you are sending everything needed for membership.

I will be using the Remind101 app to send messages throughout the season. Instructions on how to sign up are enclosed. Please join so you will stay up to date on all region news!! If you qualified for state this past season, you are already part of the group.

I know there will be lots of questions so I am here to help you all!!! ~~Please note that August 17th is the postmark deadline for the 1st rodeo.~~ I would prefer the membership documents be sent back at the same time if possible!!! And would like separate checks for entry fees & membership dues!!!

If a renewing member, District Secretary and/or State Secretary creates a new account for an existing member, it will be deleted and the member will have to go into their existing account to complete their registration. In addition, any documents uploaded into the new account will have to be uploaded into the existing account by the member.

As secretaries, you have access to all your members' profiles, which contains their usernames and email addresses.

Below are instructions on how members access their profiles, see below:

Change in procedure for entry forms

Everyone will need to fill out the following **“Contestant Approval Form”** and submit it with or prior to our first entry form.

You will no longer have to get “EACH” entry form signed by the principle or notarized; however, you **MUST** take this form to your school and have it signed by your superintendent or principle. You will also need to take this form to have it notarized. This form will stand good for your seasons entry forms as long as this form is on file with the secretary. **Entry forms will not be accepted without it on file.** You, your parents or guardians will also have to sign before submitting to secretary.

PARENTS: You will need to check the “X” box for all events that you are allowing your contestant to compete in as well as initial and date this box. If contestant enters an event that has **NOT** been checked by parent approval the computer **WILL NOT** accept the entry. Therefore, if you are considering entering other events at a later date (such as cutting) then you need to check and approve those events as well.

Welcome prospective members to the National and Texas High School Rodeo Association. We are pleased to know that you are thinking about becoming a member in this great association where **"The Elite Compete"**. Along with the requirements of the region you are thinking about joining, there are a few the THSRA requires, and so there will be no misunderstanding as to what these requirements are, they are listed below:

1. You must be in good standing, under 20 years of age, and be considered a full-time student with passing grades in 70% of classes taken. Any student attending a **private, home-school, year-round school or correspondence school**, must show proof of full-time status (passing 70% of classes) and the grade report must be a professional, computer generated document with the signatures of the teacher(s) for each subject. Any of these types of schools must be a state accredited school/program. If there are any questions, you must get pre-approved **ONE (1) MONTH PRIOR TO DEADLINES** through the THSRA State Office by calling **936-590-4447**. All students, even the ones in public school, will be required to turn in a report card or transcript with their membership application, at mid-term and at the State Finals. Any questionable documents of public, private, home, year-round or correspondence school received at deadline times will result in ineligibility of points for a minimum of two (2) rodeos, until the problem is worked out. **Any documents that are falsified will result in immediate disqualification from the association.**

2. You will be required to sell **fifteen (15) Truck Raffle tickets** by November 2020 and have these returned to your region secretary. For every five (5) tickets sold, you will receive one (1) free ticket.

3. You will be required to sell three **(3) \$50 Bloomer Trailer Raffle ticket** by November 2020 and have this returned to your region secretary.

4. You will also be required to sell at least **one (1) \$50 State Ad** for the THSRA State Finals program. For any additional ads sold, the member will receive 25% commission on the additional ad amount and your region will receive 20% commission once the total sales has reached \$350.00. The minimum \$50.00 ad will be due November 2020. Any additional ads can be sold up to March 1, 2021.

THSRA members selling the most total ads and sponsorships will receive the following awards:

1st place - Trophy saddle

2nd place - hand crafted silver/rawhide breast collar and head stall, unless the member sells over \$5,000 in ads. If your ads total over \$5,000, you will also receive a gift certificate for a trophy saddle

- Form 1099-A (acquisition or abandonment of secured property)

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN.

If you do not return Form W-9 to the requester with a TIN, you might be subject to backup withholding. See What is backup withholding, later.
